

List of documents required for employment from Belarusian citizens

Documents required for employment	Comments
Foreign passport	A notarized copy is required if there are no duplicate records in Russian.
Registration at the place of stay/residence in the Russian Federation	As per federal law, a foreign citizen entering the Russian Federation must register at the Migration service within 30 days.
SNILS or АДИ-РЕГ (ADI-REG) form	If available.
Valid insurance document (DMS/OMS)	If available. If there is no valid insurance document, please inform your recruiter.
Employment history	If available (Russian one, with the records in Russian).
TIN certificate	If available. If the number has been assigned, but there is no paper document on hand, you can send a screenshot of the record from the Federal Tax Service website.
Marriage certificate	If available. If there are no duplicate entries in Russian, a notarized copy of the translation is required.
Child's birth certificate	If available. If there are no duplicate entries in Russian, a notarized copy of the translation is required.
Education document	If available. If there are no duplicate entries in Russian, a notarized copy of the translation is required.

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
